## 1. Whose products do we offer?

- We offer products from a range of insurers.
- We can only offer products from a limited number of insurers.
- We only offer protection products from Legal & General.

## 2. Which service will we provide you with?

- We will advise and make a recommendation for you after we have assessed your protection needs.
- You will not receive advice or a recommendation from us. We may ask some questions to narrow down the selection of products that we will provide details on. You will then need to make your own choice about how to proceed.

## 3. What will you have to pay us for our services?

- A fee
- No fee for the service provided.

We will not charge you a fee, however we do receive commission from Legal & General, which is a percentage of the total annual premium, if you take out a policy through us.

You will receive a quotation which will tell you about any other fees relating to any particular insurance policy.

## 4. Who regulates us?

Nationwide Building Society, Nationwide House, Pipers Way, Swindon, Wiltshire, SN38 1NW is authorised by the Prudential Regulation Authority and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority and the Prudential Regulation Authority. Our Financial Services Register number is 106078. As an insurance intermediary we act for and on behalf of Legal & General for protection products. Our permitted business is advising on, and arranging retail packaged products. ## 6. Are we covered by the Financial Services Compensation Scheme (FSCS)?
