### Account Holding and Ownership

1. The minimum initial deposit is £100.
2. Withdrawals from the account require no notice.
3. The interest rate payable on the account is variable. From time to time, the account may have tiered interest rates, based on the balance in your account. Where this is the case, the interest rate payable on each tier is variable. When the balance in your account changes, taking you into a different tier, the interest rate for the new tier will be applied automatically.
4. Interest is credited to your account annually on 31 March and on closure. It can be transferred to your Nationwide current account or savings account (excluding Regular Savings) or to any other bank or building society current account.
