

## NATIONWIDE BUILDING SOCIETY (formerly Nationwide Anglia Building Society)

From 1<sup>st</sup> December 1991 the name and designation of the Society are “Nationwide Building Society, incorporated under the Building Societies Act 1986 and it’s having Principle Office at Nationwide House, 136 High Holborn, London WC1V 6PW.

## NATIONWIDE ANGLIA BUILDING SOCIETY

On 1<sup>st</sup> September 1987 Nationwide Building Society and Anglia Building Society merged to form Nationwide Anglia Building Society by the Transfer of the Engagements of Nationwide Building Society to Anglia Building Society, the latter subsequently changing its name to “Nationwide Anglia Building Society”.

### Deduction of Title Clause – Nationwide Deeds prior to 1<sup>st</sup> September 1987

“Which Standard Security was last vested in the said Nationwide Building Society as aforesaid and from whom we acquired right by (One) Instrument of Transfer of Engagements of Nationwide Building Society to Anglia Building Society dated Third March Nineteen Hundred and Eighty Seven; (Two) Certificate of Registration of Instrument of Transfer of Engagements issued by the Registry of Friendly Societies on First June Nineteen hundred and eighty seven; (Three) Certificate of Registration of Change of Name of Anglia Building Society to Nationwide Anglia Building Society issued by Registry of Friendly Societies on Twenty seventh August Nineteen hundred and eighty seven; and (Four) Certificate of Registration of Change of name of nationwide Anglia Building Society to nationwide Building Society issued by the Registry of Friendly Societies on First October Nineteen hundred and Ninety one”.

### Change of Name – Anglia and Nationwide Anglia Deeds

As the Society has merely changed its name, no deduction of title is required.

### Exhibition of links in Title

The keeper has seen certified copies of the Instrument of Transfer and Certificates of registration and will not require them to be submitted in connection with any application for registration in the Land register.
